## WHAT'S NEW!!

I brought in a "roll" of black raw silk (silk noir). Right now, it's on the roll and in a box. We will be cutting yard cuts from it so that we can more easily display the silk. This is most often used in embroidery for backgrounds. Anyone taking Judith Baker Montano's classes--this is one of the materials she recommends.

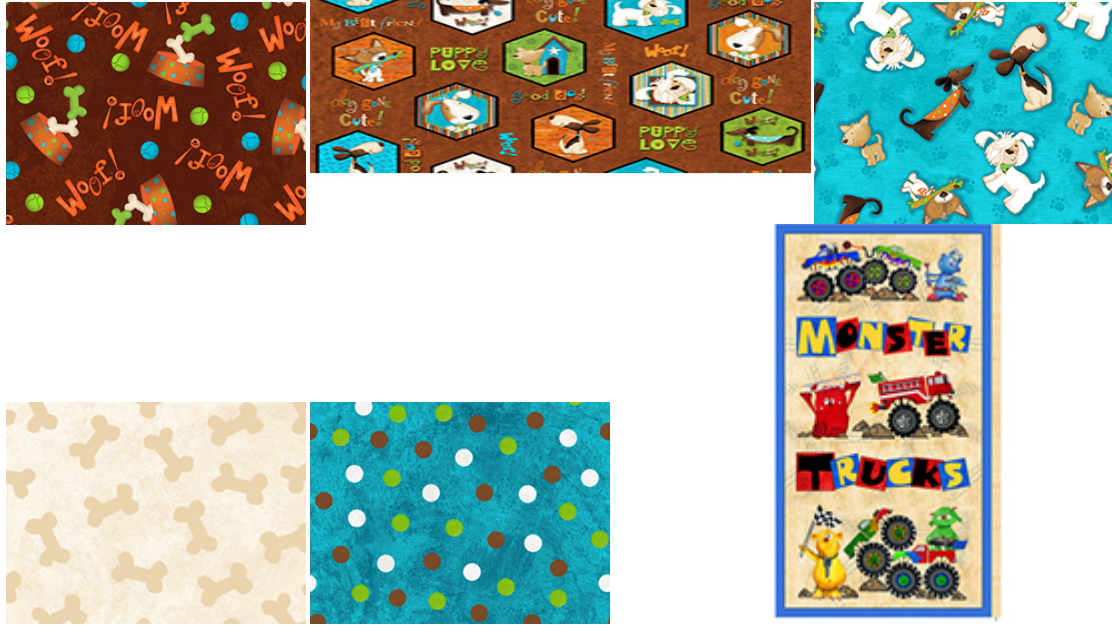
We also have in Omni Thread on big spools, wash away thread, YLI silk ribbon, some silk thread, some more Valdani thread size 12, Superior Thread on bobbins (mainly for use in applique, but can be used in bobbins in machines), buttons, Karen Buckley's Perfect scissors, and the The Gypsy Quilter Sit Upon--great for taking to classes.

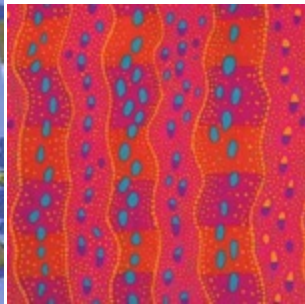

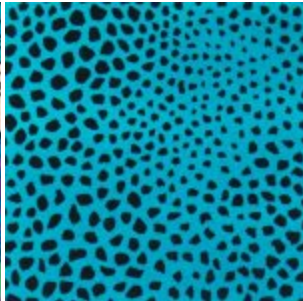

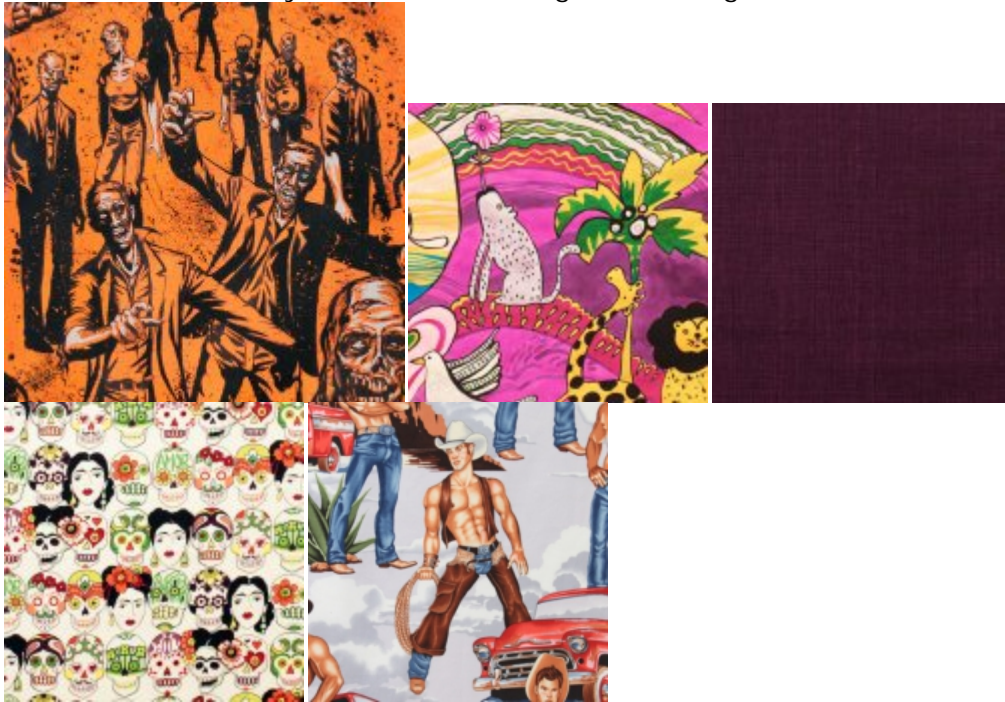
