Here is the June Block of the Month. You need to make 8. I could not upload a pdf file. Sorry. I've been trying all day. But at least you've got the written instructions. You just don't have the pics to go with.

AROUND THE BLOCK June 2020 Wild Flowers Make 8 (okay, you have until Dec to finish them) 12" X 12" finished

Cutting for all 8 blocks

A = Cut 8 background at  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " X 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " B = Cut 16 background & 16 flower at 5" X 5". C = Cut 4 background & 4 green at 9" X 9"

Sewing Instructions: BA1. Sew the B triangles together. Draw a line down the middle on the wrong side. Sew a scant 1/4"AA from either side of the line. Cut apart and square to 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 32.

B2. Sew the triangles together in pairs: Make 16 each.

BC3. Sew the C triangles together.

Draw a line down the middle on the wrong side. Sew a scant 1/4" from either side of the line. Cut apart and square to  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $8\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 8.

4. Sew an A to a set of B triangles from Step 1. Sew a set of B triangles to the left side of a C/C triangle from Step 3.

5. Sew together in rows & square to  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " X  $12\frac{1}{2}$ '. Make 8.

NOTE: This is only partially designed quilt. Not all of the blocks are done, and the extra chickens and pigs are merely placeholders. But I thought you might like to see where I think we're going.

Join the fun and come feel the difference of quality fabrics.
