NEW REQUEST

We need 600 fabric ties to go onto face shield masks for the hospital. These need to be 1/4" ties X WOF (42"), no raw edges, and stitched closed from end to end. If you have a bias tape maker, you can use the 1/2" maker and cut your strips at 1 1/8". The bias maker will fold the edges in as you press. Then all you need to do is press in half one more time and stitch closed.

I have fabric ties already cut here at the store. If you want to participate in this project, please either call & let me know or drop by and pick up fabric for ties. I have 3 people already working on this project, but the sooner we finish, the better.

We have delivered app 618 (I say app because I sometimes miss count) masks to the Cheyenne Regional Foundation, Comea shelter, first responders, clinics, nurses, doctors, vets, Fire District 2, and customers in need. And that doesn't count the several hundreds that you have made and delivered on your own.

We have kitted app 1457 and we have about 40 kits at the store ready to be sewn. We have 20 more masks ready to be delivered. (It's a constantly moving target). We are still kitting.
